

DRAIN MATTING

1. Prepare the area. Ensure the surface is level, stable and properly compacted before installation.
 2. Measure and cut. Measure the required area and trim the drain matting to size using appropriate cutting tools.
 3. Position the matting. Lay the matting flat in the desired location, ensuring full contact with the base surface.
 4. Join sections if required. Butt adjoining pieces tightly together and secure joins if specified for the project.
 5. Secure in place. Fix the matting as required for the application, such as mechanical fixing, adhesive or embedment in surrounding material.
 6. Install surrounding surface. Pour concrete, apply soil or install the finished surface material, ensuring the matting remains level and correctly positioned.
 7. Check drainage flow. Confirm water flows freely through the matting and towards the drainage outlet.
 8. Complete the surface. Finish surrounding works so final levels allow water to naturally flow toward the drain matting.
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Maintenance

- Periodically inspect for debris build-up.
- Remove sediment or blockages to maintain free water flow.
- Check surrounding surfaces remain graded toward the drainage point.
